P 45 American Music 517-520 do not have an AM prefix. Labelled Bunk Johnson, not Bunk's 3-piece band (see label photo!)

p 50 Jimmy Archey should be listed before Albert Nicholas in the session of 15 October 1947

p 51-54. Here is the history of the Columbia LP: 1950: ML 4802, 1952 GL 520, 1953: ICL 520, 195: CL 829, 1964: CL 2103, JCL 829 unknown year

I don't believe Philips B 07009 L was pressed in Germany. The Netherlands seems more likely.

p 54 Note that Philips(UK) BBL 7231 incorrectly gives the composer of Kinklets for The entertainer!

p 59 Baby. won't ... Warfield (not Warfields)

p 60 I Can't Escape ... 451121 wrong; I'm Confessin' Neiburg (nor Neiberg)

p 61 Milneberg Joys Roppolo not Rappolo

p 62 The Sheik ... Snyder, not Snider
